Katie Hill For Congress Raises More than 1.3 Million in Second Quarter

CANYON COUNTRY, CA - In an impressive display of her broad grassroots support, candidate for Congress Katie Hill today announced that her campaign closed the Second Quarter of 2018 with \$1.305 million dollars raised. Hill's total far outpaces the support in Q2 in the 2016 election cycle - when the Democratic candidate raised \$281,189 and the incumbent raised \$259,710 - and is the most ever raised by a candidate in a quarter in the district.

“Thank you to the more than 7,300 people who contributed to my campaign this quarter, and who continue to prove that our communities are hungry for change, and ready for progress,” said Hill. **“Today is further confirmation of what we already learned from the Primary Election in June - voters are tired of politics as usual, and are eager for a representative who reflects their values and makes them a priority, not special interests. I would be honored to be our community’s fiercest advocate in Washington, D.C.”**

Hill's fundraising announcement emphasizes the growing momentum behind her campaign, coming on the heels of Hill's impressive showing in the June 5 primary election, in which she edged out a crowded field of Democrats to advance to the General Election in November. The Second Quarter fundraising report also confirms the voter enthusiasm that fueled Hill's robust First Quarter fundraising, which saw more than 5,000 individuals contribute more than \$400,000.

“I am constantly inspired by the grassroots support the community is showing for our campaign,” said Finance Director, Graham Kelly. “The growing momentum behind Katie shows that voters see in her not only the best candidate for the seat, but also someone who reflects their values, who understands their needs, and who will stand up for them in Congress.”
