**Transfer of Jurisdiction Request**

Dear Judge Fitzwater:

On November 8, 2013, Charles Beltran was sentenced in the Western District of Texas, Austin Division, by U.S. District Judge Lee Yeakel to 46-months custody, to be followed by a 3-year term of supervised release for the offense of Possession of Firearm by Felon, in violation of 18 U.S.C. 922(g)(1). Mr. Beltran began his term of supervised release in the Northern District of Texas, Dallas Division, on November 23, 2016, and his expiration date is November 22, 2019.

Mr. Beltran violated his conditions of supervised release by using and possessing ecstasy, an illegal controlled substance, in or about January 2017. On January 30, 2017, Mr. Beltran submitted a urine specimen at Homeward Bound Inc. (HBI), in Dallas, that tested positive for amphetamines. On February 13, 2017, Mr. Beltran admitted, verbally and in writing, to USPO Carrie Treat that he used ecstasy on January 21, 2017.

Mr. Beltran violated his conditions of supervised release by using and possessing ecstasy, an illegal controlled substance, in or about February 2017. On February 13, 2017, Mr. Beltran submitted a urine specimen at the U.S. Probation Office, in Arlington, that tested positive for amphetamines. The same day Mr. Beltran admitted, verbally and in writing, to USPO Carrie Treat, that he used ecstasy on February 9, 2017.

Mr. Beltran violated his conditions of supervised release by unlawfully using and possessing Adderall, a controlled substance not prescribed to him, in or about July 2017. On July 18, 2017, Mr. Beltran submitted a urine specimen at HBI, in Dallas, that tested positive for amphetamines. On August 3, 2017, Mr. Beltran admitted, verbally and in writing, to USPO Carrie Treat that he used Adderall, not prescribed to him by a physician, on July 14, 2017.

Mr. Beltran violated his conditions of supervised release, as evidenced by his arrest when he unlawfully possessed marijuana on September 4, 2017, by officers of the Grand Prairie, Texas, Police Department for Possession of Marijuana Less Than 2 Ounces, in violation of Texas Health and Safety Code § 481.032, a Class B misdemeanor. The charge remains pending.

The probation officer recommends the following action for the Court to consider:

Mr. Beltran is being supervised in the Northern District of Texas for The Western District of Texas, Case Number 1:13-CR-00239(1). It is respectfully recommended that the jurisdiction of Case Number 1:13-CR-00239(1) be accepted by the Northern District of Texas so the supervised release violations may be addressed locally. On October 6, 2017, U.S. District Judge Lee Yeakel signed an order transferring jurisdiction to the Northern District of Texas. I have enclosed two signed Probation Form 22, Transfer of Jurisdiction, for the Court's review.
