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<p>mechanism was exterior of the door, so the victim could not leave the room until he was let out. Also, there was a chain slide lock affixed to the exterior top of the door. The defendant and co-defendant also screwed a board across the exterior of the doorframe to prevent the victim from breaking out the room. Deputies noticed the only window in the room was covered with a board that was screwed to the wall. There was a ceiling fan in the room, but it did not have light bulbs in it and the chain to turn on the fan was broken. Even if the fan had worked, the victim would not have been able to use it because the defendant and co-defendant turned off the power to just that room at the circuit breaker. Furthermore, deputies saw the victim's feces on the wall and there was urine on the floor. The room was void of light, electricity, games, television and other items. The only item the victim was allowed to have was a mattress on the floor and a blanket.</p> <p>Post Miranda, the defendant and co-defendant admitted to the affiant that the normally lock the victim in his room at night for approximately eleven or twelve hours. They also said the lock him in the room when he misbehaves. The defendant and co-defendant have five daughters, and they are not treated in the manner described. The defendant and co-defendant also said the victim had to yell for them if he needed to use the bathroom, and if they heard him they would respond. It should be noted that the defendant and co-defendant said the victim usual had defecated in his room by morning.</p> <p>The affiant charged the defendant and co-defendant with one count of aggravated child abuse.</p>
