NO CONTACT ORDER

The Court orders the above-named Defendant (hereinafter "You") to have "NO CONTACT" with the person(s) named as the victim(s) in the police report in this case. You are prohibited from having any type of contact with the victim(s), either directly or indirectly. An order of no contact is effective immediately and enforceable for the duration of the pretrial release or until it is modified by the court. Unless otherwise specified by the court, the term "no contact" includes the following prohibited acts:

- You MUST NOT communicate orally or in any written form, either in person, telephonically, electronically, or in any other manner, either directly or indirectly through a third person, with the victim(s) or any other person(s) named in the order;
- You MUST NOT have any physical or violent contact with the victim(s) or other named person(s) or his or her property;
- You MUST NOT be within 500 feet of the victim's or other named person's residence, even if the defendant and the victim(s) or other named person(s) share the residence;
- You MUST NOT be within 500 feet of the victim's or other named person's vehicle, place of employment or a specified place frequented regularly by such person(s);
- You MUST NOT contact the victim(s) by email, text, Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, Snap Chat, or other electronic means;
- You MUST NOT have anyone, including your children, send messages to the victim(s);
- You MUST NOT do anything which intimidates the victim(s) in any way;

Even if it involves contact with your children or legal matters, you may not communicate with the victim(s) nor have anyone else communicate with the victim(s). You must set a hearing with the Court to determine whether contact with the children will be allowed. **YOU CANNOT CONTACT THE VICTIM(S) EVEN IF IT IS TO VIIST ANY CHILDREN UNTIL YOU GET A COURT ORDER ALLOWING CONTACT.**

The victim(s) cannot withdraw this order. EVEN IF THE VICTIM(S) WOULD LIKE TO HAVE CONTACT WITH YOU, YOU MUST NOT HAVE ANY CONTACT WITH THE VICTIM(S) UNTIL THE COURT CHANGES THIS NO CONTACT ORDER IN WRITING. If you want to change this No Contact Order, you MUST appear before the Judge to change it in writing.


If you violate any conditions of this **NO CONTACT ORDER**, it is a new criminal offense. Under certain circumstances, the Court can hold you in jail without bail until this case is resolved.
