THE BELOW NAMED COMPLAINANT BEING DULY SWORN, ON INFORMATION AND BELIEF STATES THAT:

Count 1: HIT AND RUN - ATTENDED VEHICLE

The above-named defendant on or about Saturday, July 10, 2021, at 3700 North Sherman Boulevard, in the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, did operate a vehicle involved in an accident that resulted in damage to a vehicle which is driven or attended by any person and failed to reasonably investigate what was struck and if the operator knew or had reason to know that the accident resulted in injury or death of a person or in damage to a vehicle that is driven or attended by a person, and failed to stop the vehicle he was operating as close to the scene of the accident as possible and remain at the scene of the accident until he did the all of the following: give his name, address and the registration number of the vehicle he was operating to the operator or occupant of or person attending any vehicle collided with and, upon request and if available, exhibit his operator's license to the operator or occupant of or person attending any vehicle collided with, contrary to sec. 346.67(1), 346.74(5)(a) Wis. Stats.

Upon conviction for this offense, a Misdemeanor, the defendant shall be fined not less than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300) nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), or imprisoned for not more than six (6) months, or both.

Probable Cause:

I am a City of Milwaukee law enforcement officer and I base this complaint upon a review of official Milwaukee Police Department incident reports regularly kept in the course of business and prepared pursuant to the investigation of the incident herein described. I have relied on such incident reports in the past and found them to be truthful and reliable. Said incident reports indicate the following facts:

On the above date at approximately 1:40PM Milwaukee Police Department Police Officer Lammers responded to the vicinity of N. 49th Street and W. Hope Avenue to investigate a Shots Fired call for service. The 911 caller (subsequently identified as KF (02/03/1986 d.o.b.)) stated that she was following a car which had struck her car at N. Sherman Boulevard and W. Congress Street. KF described the striking vehicle as a dark-colored SUV with no plates and window tint.

KF stated further that as she was following the striking SUV, she observed it get into a second car accident at the above location. KF stated that the SUV fled from this second crash scene, and she continued to follow it.

KF stated that the striking vehicle pulled over in the 5000 block of W. Congress Street. The driver exited the SUV and spoke with KF. The driver identified himself as "Terrell" and provided to KF a phone number of 414-933-8306. The driver then got back into the SUV and drove south down an alley from Congress Street.

P.O. Lammers subsequently located a Mitsubishi Outlander SUV with severe front end damage in a parking lot in the 4400 block of W. Congress Street. The Mitsubishi had no registration plates displayed. The driver and sole occupant of this damaged SUV was subsequently identified as the above-named defendant. The defendant told P.O. Lammers that his phone number was 414-933-8306. KF advised that the defendant was the person she observed get into the crash and flee from the above location.

P.O. Llanas responded to the above location at approximately 1:45PM on the above date to assist with an Accident/Personal Injury call for service. Upon arrival, P.O. Llanas located a black 4-door Lexus sedan bearing WI registration plate #AHY-8410 disabled in the northbound lane but facing south. This vehicle had significant passenger side damage, and the side airbags had deployed. The front passenger of the sedan was identified as KG (10/28/1991 d.o.b.). KG stated that he and his brother (who was driving) were northbound on N. Sherman Boulevard approaching W. Nash Street. A second vehicle struck them on the passenger side, failed to stop, and then fled south on Sherman and west on Fond du Lac Avenue. KG stated that the striking vehicle appeared to be being followed by another car. KG stated that he was experiencing pain in his right ribcage as a result of the crash.

P.O. Llanas observed the front grille of a Mitsubishi laying in the street at the above location.
