THE BELOW NAMED COMPLAINANT BEING DULY SWORN, ON INFORMATION AND BELIEF STATES THAT:

Count 1: HIT AND RUN - ATTENDED VEHICLE

The above-named defendant on or about Saturday, January 16, 2021, at North Sherman Boulevard and West Bradley Road, in the Village of Brown Deer, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, did operate a vehicle involved in an accident that resulted in damage to a vehicle which is driven or attended by any person and failed to reasonably investigate what was struck and if the operator knew or had reason to know that the accident resulted in injury or death of a person or in damage to a vehicle that is driven or attended by a person, and failed to stop the vehicle he was operating as close to the scene of the accident as possible and remain at the scene of the accident until he did the all of the following: give his name, address and the registration number of the vehicle he was operating to the operator or occupant of or person attending any vehicle collided with and, upon request and if available, exhibit his operator's license to the operator or occupant of or person attending any vehicle collided with, contrary to sec. 346.67(1), 346.74(5)(a) Wis. Stats.

Upon conviction for this offense, a Misdemeanor, the defendant shall be fined not less than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300) nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), or imprisoned for not more than six (6) months, or both.

Probable Cause:

Complainant is a law enforcement officer employed by the Village of Brown Deer Police Department, and bases this complaint on official reports prepared by Officer Shaun Foster, which are of the kind that complainant has used in the past and found to be accurate and reliable, and which complainant knows are prepared in the regular course of that department's business.

Those reports indicate that on Saturday, January 16, 2021 at approximately 10:26 PM, Officer Foster responded to a two vehicle accident that occurred at the intersection of N. Sherman Blvd. and W> Bradley Rd. in the Village of Brown Deer, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin. Upon arrival, he observed a Buick Rendezvous with two occupants inside with heavy front end damage facing west in the southbound lanes of Sherman Blvd., and a black Mercury Milan, which was crashed in the east side of Soul Food Dream, a business located at 4301 W. Bradley Rd.

Officer Foster spoke to D.B.J., a passenger of the Buick involved in the accident. D.B.J. stated that he observed the Mercury run the red light at the intersection while traveling southbound while their car was entering the intersection. The Mercury crashed into their vehicle, and D.B.J. then saw the driver of the

Mercury exit the car and run southbound away from the scene carrying a black backpack. D.B.J. attempted to run after the man, but was unable to make contact with him. The man did not provide any identifying information nor did he check on the welfare of D.B.J. or D.J.

Shortly after speaking with D.B.J., T.B. arrived on-scene. T.B. identified herself as the mother of Terrell Thompson, the above-named defendant. T.B. stated that the defendant called her and that he fled the scene because he was afraid of a man chasing him, and that he wanted to go to the hospital.

Officer Sara White responded to the incident as well in an effort to locate the defendant. Officer White located the defendant in the area of N. Sherman Blvd. and W. Fountain Ave. and placed him into custody. The defendant was transported to St. Joseph's Hospital to be treated for his injuries.

NOTICE: The state will be requesting a no contact order for the victims D.B.J. (the passenger of the Buick) and D.J. (the driver of the Buick).
